### **Rooms**

To respect the sanitary standards recommended by Hôtellerie Suisse, the hospitality products are not offered in the room, but are available, on request, at the reception desk.

The minibar is accessible.

With the application of hygiene standards, a delayed check-in could be caused.

### **Restaurant**

To guarantee distancing as well as affluence, we offer 2 time slots for breakfast and dinner.

For the evening, we offer a à la carte choice as well as balanced 3-course choice menu. A children's menu is also available.

### **Thermal bath - Wellness**

The wellness and thermal bath area are only accessible to hotel guests.

Massages and treatments are possible and can be booked at our reception.

### **Safety measures**

- Crossing points are cleaned and disinfected several times a day.
- Tables in the restaurant and lobby are spaced.
